Notice is hereby given that Garfield County Rural Water District No. 5 c/o Jeff Coe, 2548 NW Expressway Suite 102, Oklahoma City, OK 73112, under the authority given in Oklahoma State Law, Title 82 §1020.7, has filed an application with the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, pursuant to Board rules, to amend groundwater permit #1982-878 by deleting one (1) well and adding one (1) well located as follows: deleting one (1) well in the SE SE SE and adding one (1) well in the SW SW SE; both in Section 32, T20N, R8W1M, Kingfisher County. This will bring the total number of wells for this permit to six (6). The land dedicated to the permit is 535 acres with a total of 1,070 acre-feet of groundwater per calendar year for the purpose of public water supply (rural water systems). All other aspects of the permit remain the same, viewable at [oklahoma.gov/owrb](http://oklahoma.gov/owrb). Wells and dedicated lands are located over the Alluvium and Terrace Deposits of the Cimarron River groundwater basin. Use of groundwater is governed by Sections 1020.1 and following of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes and rules of the Board, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC), Title 785, Chapters 4 & 30.

Protests to the application must be in writing and received by the Board at the address listed below and by the applicant at the address listed above no later than December 22, 2025, and contain the following:

According to the report, the 31-year-old male suspect appeared to exhibit

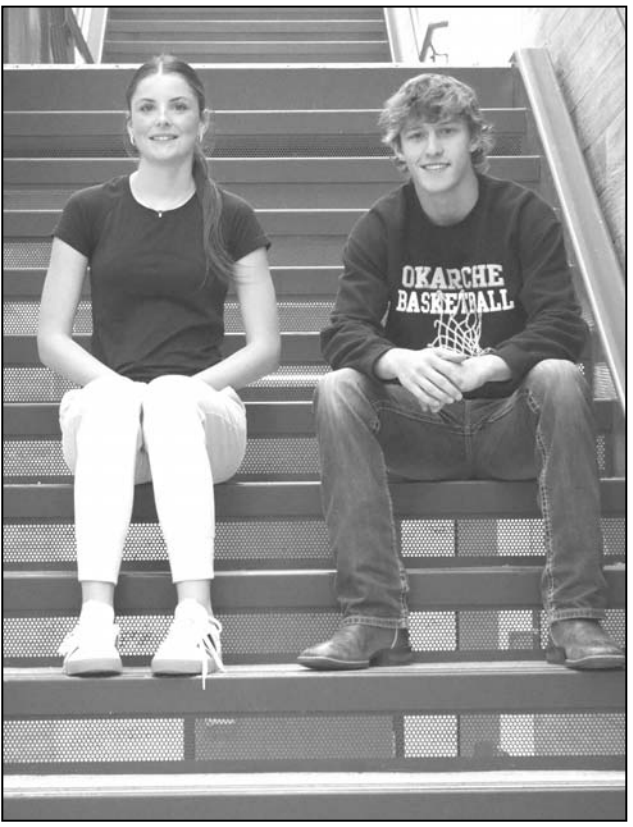
signs of intoxication and field sobriety tests were performed.
