PUBLIC NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF DRAFT TIER II PERMIT

POLLUTANT DISCHARGE APPLICATION NO. OK0028291

Notice is hereby given that the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has issued a draft permit to the Ottawa County Rural Water and Sewer District (RW&SD) #1, 212 S. Main St., Wyandotte, OK 74370, based on a Tier II application filed on October 6, 2025, for a renewal permit with DEQ. A final permit, if issued, would allow the Ottawa County RW&SD #1 to discharge treated municipal wastewater from the Ottawa County RW&SD #1 Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF), which is located at E157 & S642 Rd., Wyandotte, OK 74370, or in the NE¼, SW¼, SW¼ of Section 28, Township 27 North, Range 24 East, IM, Ottawa County, Oklahoma. The Ottawa County RW&SD #1 WWTF is a municipal facility that accepts domestic wastewater. The proposed discharge consists of treated effluent from the Ottawa County RW&SD #1 WWTF. The discharge from Outfall 001, which is located at latitude 36° 47' 10.573" N, longitude 94° 43' 51.415" W (GPS: NAD83) in Ottawa County, Oklahoma, will be to an unnamed tributary into Grand Lake O' the Cherokees. The biosolids generated by the facility are beneficially used by land application in Sections 18, 19, and 27, Township 27 North, Range 24 East, IM, Ottawa County, Oklahoma.

Main St., Wyandotte, OK 74370, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Pursuant to 27A O.S. § 2-14-302, people wishing to request a public meeting concerning the draft permit may do so by filing the request in writing to the Contact Person for DEQ, at the address listed above, within 30 days after the date of publication or mailing. Requests for the public meeting should include: (1) name and address of the interested person, (2) the application name to which the request relates, (3) the nature and basis of the interest of the person affected, and (4) a statement of objection or comment, the basis of the objection or comment, and any requested action by DEQ. A copy of the request must also be sent to the applicant, through the contact person listed above. A formal public meeting may be scheduled if there is a significant degree of public interest. Notice of the date, time and place of the public meeting will be given to all parties of record. A request for a public meeting may be combined with a submission of written comments.

If a public meeting is held, oral or written comments will be accepted at the meeting. DEQ shall, within 90 days of the date the public comment period closes (or longer if extended by the Executive Director of DEQ), issue responses to all public comments received.


