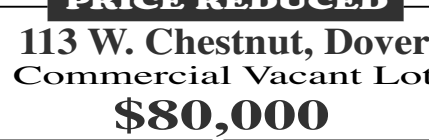

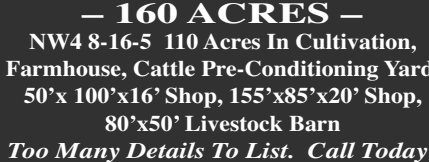

The wheat coming in now is a little better than expected, it was reported. A little has come in slightly damp but a couple more dry, sunny days are expected to push harvest into high gear.

Early-harvested wheat has been in the 20-bushel-per-acre and up range with moisture at acceptable levels.

• Cashion Grain and Feed Elevator – Harvest is just getting started but the elevator has taken in some 50-bushel-per-acre wheat and the harvest overall appears to be a little better than expected. Some 25-bushel wheat has been reported on early-harvested fields. Test weights are generally good, testing in the 60-pound range.

A couple more days of sunny, dry weather is needed to put the harvest in high gear there.

• Kingfisher CHS Elevator – Local Manager Chris Townsley reported the crop appears to be a little better than expected thus far with some yields

in the 50s. However some yields have been in the 15-bushel range, reflecting the abnormal crop year. Test weights have been holding up well.

All local elevators stayed open late Monday to facilitate late harvesters.

Wheeler Brothers Elevator at Omega reported that harvest had just started Monday and a .3 inch shower overnight, along with cloudy skies, was expected to slow it down more on Tuesday.

CHS Elevator at Omega also had made a start in the harvest with Dennis Fisher bringing in the first load.

A “pretty major” hail storm in the region also has caused wheat losses, but some fields are expected to be “okay,” it was reported.

Hennessey CHS Elevator had not received new-harvest grain Tuesday morning and a spokesperson predicted it would not begin there possibly until the end of the week.

In accordance with Oklahoma Statutes, Title 34, Section 17, notice is hereby given that the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Statutes will appear on the Ballot for the Primary Election to be held June 16, 2026. A “YES” vote is a vote in favor of a measure or proposal. A “NO” vote is a vote against a measure or proposal.

Ballot Title State Question 832, Initiative Petition 446

This measure amends the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act (“OMWA”) under the Oklahoma Statutes to increase the state minimum wage. Employers must pay employees at least \$9 per hour beginning in 2025, increasing \$1.50 annually for a final rate of \$15 per hour in 2029. Beginning in 2030 and continuing indefinitely, the minimum wage would automatically increase annually based on the increase in the cost of living, if any, as measured by the U.S. Department of Labor’s Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers; the minimum wage increase would continue with any successor agency or index. Such increase would also not require approval from Congress or the Oklahoma Legislature. This measure eliminates several exemptions in the current OMWA, including the exemptions for employers subject to the federal Fair Labor Standards Act; part-time employees; certain students and individuals under age 18; farm and agricultural workers; domestic service workers; newspaper vendors or carriers; and feedstore employees. Effectively, eliminating these exemptions results in current employees not covered by the OMWA now being entitled to the minimum wage. The measure also repeals title 40, section 197.5.

Federal and state employees will not be covered under the OMWA. Volunteers; employers with ten or fewer employees and grossing \$100,000 or less; some employees of carriers engaged in interstate commerce; employees working in a bona fide executive, administrative, or professional capacity; outside salesmen; and reserve deputy sheriffs will remain excluded from the OMWA’s coverage. Because counties, municipalities, and school districts are not excluded, a fiscal impact on the State will result, possibly necessitating a revenue increase by new taxes or elimination of existing services. The measure will be effective the January 1 following approval and will not apply retroactively.
