Notice is hereby given that the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has issued a draft permit to the Big Cabin Public Works Authority (PWA), P.O. Box 161, Big Cabin, OK-74332, based on a Tier II application filed on December 1, 2025, for a renewal permit with DEQ. A final permit, if issued, would allow the Big Cabin PWA to discharge treated municipal wastewater from their facility, the Big Cabin Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) which is located at NS 4360 Rd, Big Cabin, OK-74332, or in the W1/2, W1/2, Section 25, Township 24N, Range 19E, IM, Craig County, Oklahoma. Big Cabin WWTP is a municipal facility that accepts domestic and industrial wastewater. The proposed discharge consists of effluent from the Big Cabin WWTP. The discharge from Outfall 001, which is located

at latitude 36° 30' 57.059" N, longitude 95° 15' 40.985" W (GPS: NAD83) in Craig County, Oklahoma, will be into an unnamed tributary to Rock Creek. The sewage sludge generated by the facility is self-contained within the lagoon system. A final permit, if issued, would allow the Big Cabin WWTP to supply treated wastewater (also known as reclaimed water) from their facility for irrigation of hay fields on five sites located in the NW1/4, NW1/4, SW1/4 (Sites R01-R03), and in the E1/2 (Sites R04-R05);
Section 25, Township 24 North, Range 19 East, IM, Craig County, Oklahoma.

Pursuant to 27A O.S. §2-14-302, people wishing to request a public meeting concerning the draft permit may do so by filing the request in writing to the Contact Person for DEQ, at the

address listed above, within 30 days after the date of publication or mailing. Requests for the public meeting should include: (1) name and address of the interested person, (2) the application name to which the request relates, (3) the nature and basis of the interest of the person affected, and (4) a statement of objection or comment, the basis of the objection or comment, and any requested action by DEQ. A copy of the request must also be sent to the applicant, through the contact person listed above. A formal public meeting may be scheduled if there is a significant degree of public interest. Notice of the date, time and place of the public meeting will be given to all parties of record. A request for a public meeting may be combined with a submission of written comments. If a public meeting is held, oral or written comments will be accepted at the meeting. DEQ shall, within 90 days of the date the public comment period closes (or longer if extended by the Executive Director of DEQ), issue responses to all public comments received.
