ORDINANCE NO. 2026-03-01 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NOWATA, OKLAHOMA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE NOWATA MUNICIPAL CODE, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 11-105 TITLED "BOARD OF CEMETERY TRUSTEES, APPOINTMENT AND CREATION", SECTION 11-106 TITLED "POWERS AND DUTIES OF CEMETERY TRUSTEES", AND SECTION 11-107 TITLED "CEMETERY EXPENSES AND COLLECTIONS"; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioner of City of Nowata believe that it is in the best interest of the City to revise and restate Sections 11-105, 11-106, and 11-107 of the Nowata Municipal Code to provide for a committee structure to oversee and/or assist in future planning, current maintenance, and issues with individual gravesites that may occur from time to time regarding headstones, and issues related to the placement removal, and/or denial of ornaments, statutes, and other similar devices at or near gravesites.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Nowata, Oklahoma, meeting in regular session at the Nowata Fire Station, in Nowata, Oklahoma this 2nd day of March, 2026, as follows, to wit: Section One (1): The following Sections 11-105, 11-106, and 11-107 of Chapter 11 are hereby amended in their entity, restated, and are hereby approved, ordained, established and codified into the Code of Ordinances of the City of Nowata, Oklahoma, as follows, to wit:

**SECTION 11-105 BOARD OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE, APPOINTMENT AND CREATION**

In regard to the Nowata Municipal Cemetery, the Board of Commissioners may create, establish and appoint a Cemetery Committee. If established, the Cemetery Committee shall consist of three (3) members. The term of each member will be three (3) years, except that when and if the Committee is first appointed, one member shall serve a term of one (1) year, one member shall serve a term of two (2) years, and one member shall serve a term of three (3) years.

**SECTION 11-106 POWERS AND DUTIES OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE**

When established by the Board of Commissioners, the Cemetery Committee shall:

1. Make recommendations to the City Commission regarding future planning, current maintenance, and general conditions.
2. Have the authority to hear and decide issues that may arise with individual gravesites that may occur from time to time regarding headstones, and issues related to the placement removal, and/or denial of ornaments, statutes, and other similar devices at or near gravesites.

**SECTION 11-107 CEMETERY FUNDS, AND DONATIONS**

The Cemetery Committee shall not receive any funds from the sale of lots and spaces, nor from any source, and those individuals, entities, or groups wishing to donate for the benefit of the Cemetery shall be directed by the Committee to the City Treasurer and/or the Trustees of the Perpetual Care Fund of the Nowata Municipal Cemetery (C-86-137).

Section Two (2) Severability. If any provision, Section, Subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance or the applicable thereof to any person or circumstances is held to be unconstitutional, illegal or in conflict, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, or by any federal agency, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provisions to other persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby, and to this end, such portion of the Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent, provision and not affecting the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section Three (3) Repealer. Any Ordinance or Code provision, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are, to that extent, hereby repealed.

Section Four (4) Emergency Clause, Effective Date. There being an immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication one time, but its effective from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02-02 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NOWATA, OKLAHOMA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AMENDING SECTION 17-302, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NOWATA, TITLED "WASTEWATER TREATMENT RATE" AND SECTION 17-213, TITLED "WATER RATES" BY INCREASING THE AMOUNT CHARGED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by majority vote of the City of Nowata Board of Commissioners at a Special Meeting on the 23rd day of February, 2026, it was determined, upon the recommendation of City Administration that an increase in the rates charged for water and wastewater services is necessary to provide for a balanced budget for the current and upcoming fiscal year, to account for inflation and for additional expenses related to equipment, the new water tower,

and operations, including the increased liability related to the State Legislature's increase of the allowable claim limits under the Governmental Tort Claims Act. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Nowata, Oklahoma, meeting in regular session on this 23rd day of February, 2026, as follows: Section One (1): That Section 17-302, titled "Wastewater Treatment Rate" of the Code of Ordinances, City of Nowata, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit: **SECTION 17-302 WASTEWATER TREATMENT RATE**

All users of the wastewater treatment system shall be charged Twenty Dollars and Thirty-four Cents (\$20.34) per month for the first one thousand (1000) gallons of metered consumption, plus a charge of Six Dollars and Twenty-six Cents (\$6.26) for each additional one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water usage.

Section Two (2): Section 17-213, titled "Water Rates", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Nowata, Oklahoma, shall be amended to read as follows;

**SECTION 17-213 WATER RATES**

There shall be a minimum base charge for water services of Eighteen Dollars and Fifty-three Cents (\$18.53) per user per month for the first one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water used; plus an additional Five Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$5.70) per thousand gallon for the next two thousand (2,000) gallons of metered water used; an additional Six Dollars and Twenty-six Cents (\$6.26) per thousand gallons for the next one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water used; and an additional Six Dollars and Eighty-Eight Cents (\$6.88) per thousand gallons of metered water thereafter.

All Rural Water Districts shall be charged Seven Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$7.35) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water consumption.

**Section Three (3) Severability.** If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, illegal or in conflict, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, or by any federal agency, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provisions to other persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby, and to this end, such portion of the Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent, provision and not affecting the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

**Section Four (4): Repealer.** Any Ordinance or Code provision, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are to that extent hereby repealed.

**Section Five (5): Emergency Clause, Effective Date.**

There being an immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication one time, but its effective date shall commence at the beginning of the next billing cycle for the Nowata Municipal Authority.
