A person who sends a letter containing only a general objection or comment will not be deemed to be a party, but the letter will be made part of the permanent record.

If a protest that meets the requirements listed in the paragraph above is filed with both the applicant and Board., a hearing on this application will be scheduled and the applicant and protestant(s) will be advised of the hearing date. Protestants or their representatives must appear at the hearing and present the protest to be considered. Hearings are governed by Section 309 of Title 75 and Section 105.11 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and the rules of Board, OAC Title 785, chapters 4 and 20. Present were Chairman, Jason Kienholz, County Commissioner District #1; Vice-Chairman, Gary May, County Commissioner District #2; Member, Nick Hughes, County Commissioner District #3; and Secretary, Connie Smith, County Clerk.
