Oklahoma Department of  
Environmental Quality (DEQ) has  
published a draft permit to the City  
of Collinsville, 106 N. 12th St.,  
Collinsville, OK 74021, based on a  
Tier II application filed on August 18,  
2025, for a renewal permit with DEQ.  
A final permit, if issued, would allow  
the City of Collinsville to discharge  
treated effluent backwash water from  
their facility, the Collinsville Water  
Treatment Plant (WTP), which is  
located in the SW4, NW4, NE4 of  
Section 22, Township 22 North,  
Range 14 East, M. Rogers County,  
Oklahoma. The Collinsville WTP  
is a municipal facility that provides  
public water services. The proposed  
discharge consists of treated effluent

from the Collinsville WTP. The  
discharge from Outfall 001, which  
is located at latitude 36° 22' 39.234"  
N, longitude 95° 45' 01.496" W  
GPS: NAD83, in Rogers County,  
Oklahoma, will be to Collinsville  
Lake. The residuals generated by  
the facility are beneficially used as  
fill material at a pasture site located  
in Section 22, Township 22 North,  
Range 14 East, Rogers County, OK.

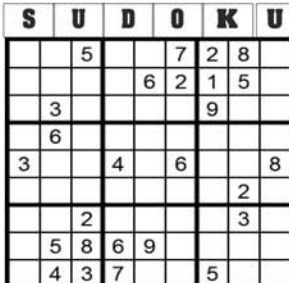
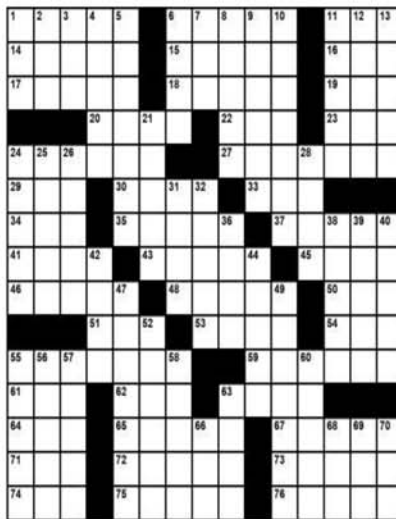
