WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to clarify and expressly authorize the use of the Special Fireman's Fund for personnel costs directly associated with providing fire protection services, while preserving the restricted and special revenue character of the Fund.

SECTION 2. PRESERVATION OF RESTRICTED FUND STATUS Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to convert the Special Fireman's Fund into a general fund. The Fund shall remain a restricted special revenue fund, and expenditures shall be limited strictly to the purposes stated herein and as appropriated in the Town's annual budget.

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL LABOR LAW This Ordinance is intended to permit nominal compensation to volunteer firefighters without altering their status as volunteers under the Fair Labor Standards Act. The Town shall administer such compensation practices in a manner consistent with applicable federal regulations.

SECTION 4. BUDGET APPROPRIATION REQUIRED No expenditure for personnel costs shall be made from the Special Fireman's Fund unless and until such expenditures have been lawfully appropriated by the Board of Trustees in the municipal budget for the applicable fiscal year.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remaining provisions shall not be affected.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, approval and publication as required by law. PASSED AND APPROVED this 11th day of May, 2026.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 85 CHAPTER 5, SECTION 3 OF THE TOWN ORDINANCES BY REPLACING THE ADVISORY LIBRARY BOARD WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF LOCUST GROVE TO SERVE AS THE LIBRARY BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A BOARD MEMBER AS LIAISON BETWEEN THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE LIBRARY DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance Title 8 Chapter 5 Section 3 creating the Public Library and the Library Advisory Board to advise the Town Trustees on library planning and policy matters; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees approved Ordinance 2012-001 on February 20, 2012, which amended Ordinance 2006-1 to dissolve the Library Board;

and WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2012-001 was not published as required by 11 O. S. 514-106. Therefore, the Ordinance did not become effective; and

WHEREAS, the current Board of Trustees finds it imperative and feasible to perform or cause to be performed all duties required by Ordinance or other law by a director of libraries and to perform such other duties as may be required; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LOCUST GROVE, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION 1. The Board of Trustees finds and declares that part of Title 8, Chapter 5, Section 3 of the Ordinances of the Town of Locust Grove, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 8-5-3 LIBRARY BOARD

A. The Locust Grove Public Library shall be governed by the Locust Grove Board of Trustees under the day-to-day management of a Library Director as may be appointed as needed by the Locust Grove Board of Trustees, as provided under the provisions of 11 O. S. 31-101 et seq.

B. The Board of Trustees may elect one trustee to serve as liaison between the Board of Trustees and the Library Director for a term of one year.

SECTION 2. All former Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon approval and publication as required by law. PASSED AND APPROVED on this 11th day of May 2026.
