





than Haskell Lemon's. The entire list of bidders and their bids appeared on Page 2 of the Wednesday, Jan. 14, edition of the Times and Free Press.

Shawna Rupp, executive director of the Kingfisher Chamber of Commerce, asked for the county commissioners' assistance in a project under way involving the chamber and Chisholm Trail Technology Center to provide a database of names on the courthouse centennial wall.


