AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE MODULAR HOME PARKS, MOBILE HOME PARKS, TRAVEL TRAILER PARKS AND/ OR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS IN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF ADAIR, OKLAHOMA, EXCLUDING THE EXISTING MOBILE HOME PARK THAT IS ALREADY ESTABLISHED. NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ADAIR, MAYES COUNTY, OKLAHOMA: WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Adair, Oklahoma, deem it desirable for the benefit of the Town of Adair, Oklahoma that no modular home parks, mobile home parks, travel trailer parks and/or recreational vehicle parks shall be allowed in the Town limits of the Town of Adair, Oklahoma, excluding the existing mobile home park that is already established.

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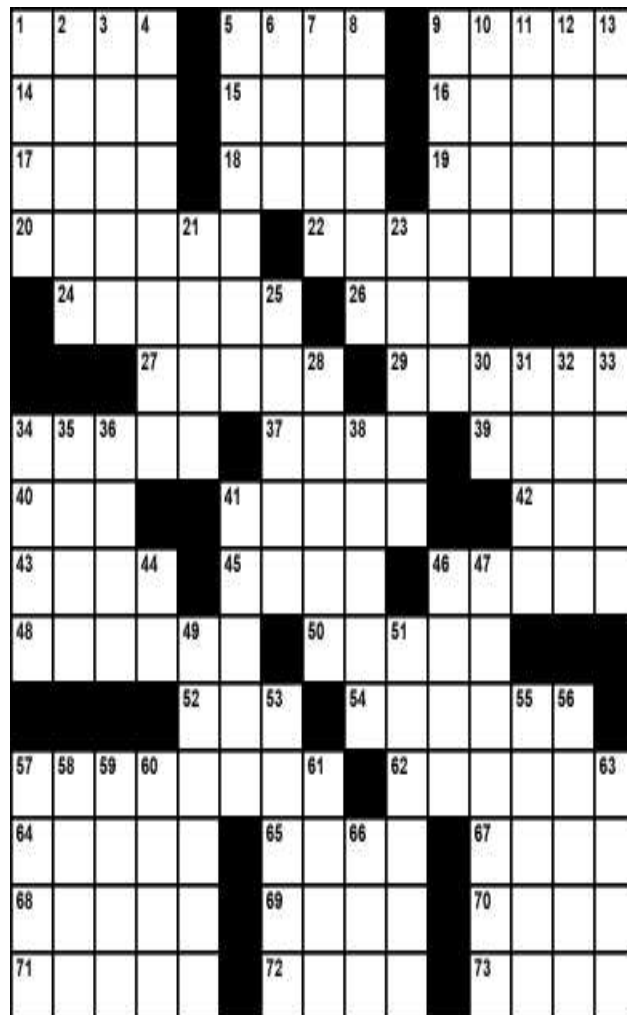

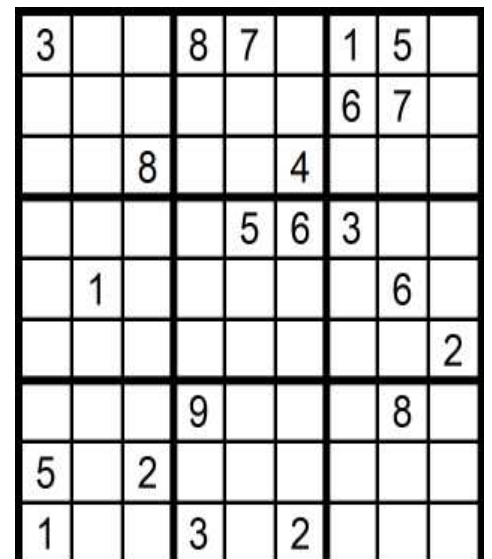

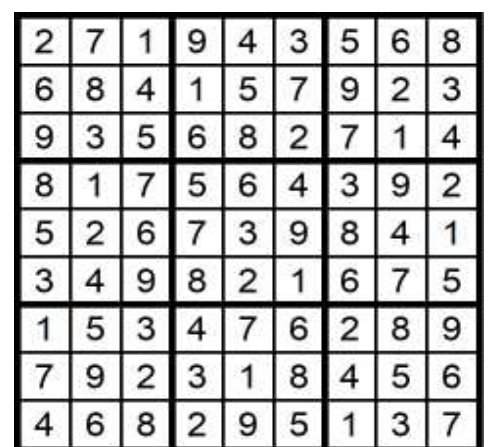
