## Grove man accused of using toddler to make child pornography

A Grove man is in federal custody on charges of producing child sexual abuse materials involving a one-year-old child.

A federal grand jury indicted Adrian Parker Gaines, 38, on charges of production, possession, and receipt and distribution of child pornography. Authorities say, Gaines confessed to producing, receiving, and distributing child sexual abuse materials.

Among the files recovered by the FBI were screenshots “(that) revealed the exchange of numerous videos and images depicting children being sexually abused,” the nine-page criminal complaint states.

According to court records, Gaines told investigators he was introduced to TeleGuard in late 2023 or early 2024,

while attempting to buy drugs online. There, he said he was introduced to a group that directed him to another group where the users were sharing child sexual abuse materials, the indictment reads. TeleGuard is an encrypted-based messenger platform.

Gaines claimed he was initially not interested in the content being shared and tried to report it, but eventually started sending and receiving the child sexual abuse materials, according to investigators.

In January 2025, the FBI says it received information regarding user “EMMA” who was operating a group entitled the “Unicorn Elite Group.” The group focused primarily on the sharing and trading of child sexual abuse material. It was described as a place for parents of children, specifically daughters ages 0-9, to share first-generation child pornography.

To join the group, and/or maintain

membership, investigators say users were required to supply multiple verification images or videos of their own produced child sexual abuse material. The complaint details a video that describes Gaines allegedly removing the crying child’s skirt and diaper and using a pen to write “Wolf 69 sun” in her diaper area. Gaines is also seen allegedly touching and exposing the child’s genitals to a camera as she cried, the complaint states.

He confessed to writing “Wolf 69 sun” on the toddler’s body at the request of a person identified as “Wolf 69 sun” but he only produced the one video depicting the toddler and at no other point did he have sexual contact with her, the complaint states. Investigators say Gaines admitted he exchanged images from one to five individuals on both TeleGuard and Telegram from early 2024 through February 2025.
