Weatherford woman sentenced for assault and battery in Custer County Court

A Weatherford woman, Whitney Lynn Bull, has been found guilty of Assault & Battery and sentenced in the Custer County District Court, records show.

The judgment and sentence, filed on November 18, 2025, states that Ms. Bull was found guilty of one count of Assault & Battery, a misdemeanor offense (21 O.S. § 644(B)), related to an incident committed on or about July 16th, 2024.

According to the Judgment and Sentence, Bull was sentenced to serve 90 days in the custody of the Custer County Jail. The Court ordered that 80 days of this sentence be suspended, leaving 10 days to be served. The remaining time is subject to the rules and conditions of probation entered by the Court. The sentence terms were

ordered to run concurrently with a previous case against Bull, CM-2023-440, for unauthorized use of a credit card.

The charges stemmed from an altercation at an apartment complex on State Street in Weatherford. An Affidavit of Probable Cause filed earlier in the year detailed the incident, reporting that Ms. Bull confronted the victim, identified as D.L., leading to a physical fight. The affidavit describes the confrontation as involving grabbing, hitting, kneeling and the defendant allegedly being tripped and pushing D.L. back into the wall of the building.

In addition to the time served and probation, Bull was ordered to pay court costs, including a fine of \$300.00 and a VCA (Victim Compensation Act) fee of \$35.00, along with other court assessments.
