A systematic review and meta-analysis estimating the differences in bleeding risks between therapeutic-dose non-vitamin K oral anticoagulants (NOACs) and single antiplatelet therapy (aspirin) found that rates of major bleeding for therapeutic-dose apixaban and dabigatran were similar to low-dose aspirin, but rates were higher for rivaroxaban. These findings can help patients with atrial fibrillation (AF) and clinicians better understand the bleeding risks associated with anticoagulants versus aspirin. The study is published in *Annals of Internal Medicine*.

Certain hormonal contraceptives are associated with a higher stroke and heart attack risk, finds a large study published in *The BMJ* that draws on prescription records to give more precise estimates for different products than previous studies. The highest risk estimates were for estrogen containing products, in particular the vaginal ring and skin patch. However, the absolute risk remains low. Almost 250 million women worldwide are estimated to use hormonal contraception. Previous studies have suggested a potential increased risk of ischemic stroke and heart attack with their use, but findings have been inconsistent.
