gan Cansler, Kingfisher County 4-H Leader.

Cansler, a registered nurse and instructor with Northwest Technology Center in Fairview, taught the American Heart Association Heartsaver CPR course and certified participants in CPR and first aid.

"The skills learned through this clinic help youth build confidence while preparing them to provide safe and responsible care for children," said Heather Leitner, Kingfisher County 4-H Extension educator/4-H youth development. "Participants gained practical experience that will benefit them both as babysitters and as future leaders in their communities."

Leitner added that the babysitting clinic equips youth with essential life skills, promotes responsibility and provides families with access to trained babysitters who understand child safety, age-appropriate care and emergency response procedures.

Leitner said the increased attendance this year indicates the growing interest among local youth in developing caregiving and leadership skills.

These ordinances are not intended to punish responsible pet owners.

They exist to protect our neighborhoods, reduce conflicts between neighbors, lessen the burden on law enforcement and prevent unnecessary injuries and euthanizations.

Being a responsible dog owner is part of being a good neighbor.

Kingfisher is a wonderful community filled with good people and the majority are good pet owners.

This article is simply a reminder that we all share responsibility for maintaining a safe, respectful and peaceful community.

Dogs enrich our lives in countless ways, but with the privilege of owning a dog comes the obligation to control, train and care for it responsibly.

If each of us does our part, we can reduce injuries, ease tensions between neighbors, lessen the burden on law enforcement and, most importantly, prevent needless injuries for both people and animals alike.

Summary of the Kingfisher Animal Ordinances

The City of Kingfisher's animal ordinances are designed to protect public safety, promote responsible pet ownership and maintain good neighbor relationships throughout the community.

Some of the key provisions include:

- Dogs and other animals may not run at-large and must be properly restrained or confined.

- Owners are responsible for preventing excessive barking and nuisance behavior.

- Dogs and cats must comply with rabies vaccination requirements.

- Owners are responsible for properly securing and controlling their animals at all times.

- Dangerous or vicious animals are prohibited within the city limits.

- Animals running loose may be impounded by law enforcement or animal control officers.

- Owners may be required to pay impoundment fees and fines before redeeming animals.

- Repeated violations may result in increased penalties, court action or destruction of dangerous animals.

- Animal cruelty, neglect and abandonment are prohibited.
