

Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board now accepting grant applications

The Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board, chaired by Oklahoma Attorney General Gentner Drummond, is now accepting grant applications from eligible political subdivisions across the state. Counties, municipalities, public trusts, and collaborative/joint applications are eligible to apply for \$180,000 to \$2.25 million for a three-year project.

"These grants represent a vital tool in our ongoing battle against the opioid epidemic that has devastated families and communities throughout Oklahoma," said Drummond. "By providing resources directly to local governments and organizations on the front lines, we can make a meaningful difference in saving lives and helping those struggling with addiction find the path to recovery."

The grants support treatment and recovery programs, assistance with co-occurring disorders and mental health issues, opioid abuse education and prevention, proper prescription efforts, and strategies to decrease the supply

of narcotics across the state. Applicants may submit proposals based on a set of board-approved priority strategies.

In 2020, the Oklahoma Legislature created the Opioid Abatement Board to manage opioid settlement funds and support efforts to combat the crisis; however, no funds were distributed until Drummond took office. Since 2023, nearly \$30 million in grants have been awarded to more than 100 communities across the state.

Recent provisional data from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) show drug overdose deaths are declining in the state. Drug overdose deaths in Oklahoma declined 41% year-over-year, dropping from 1,089 during September 2023–2024 to 642 during September 2024–2025, according to the CDC.

"The data proves these investments are saving lives. A 41% drop in overdose deaths represents hundreds of Oklahomans who are still here with their families. We are



committed to building on this progress, and I encourage every eligible community to apply for these funds and join us in turning the tide on this epidemic once and for all," Drummond said

Grant applications close March 31. The

Opioid Abatement Board will then thoroughly review them from April through June.

Grant awards will be announced in August.

SST offers reduced rates to eligible consumers under two programs. Lifeline Service is a monthly discount on local service charges that is available to qualified customers, and Link Up helps customers connect to the national telephone network at no charge. This allows SST to waive the normal \$100 installation fee for the first-time qualified customers. Qualifying low-income individuals subscribing to residential services that are eligible for Lifeline and Link Up telephone assistance programs will receive discounts off basic local charges and are eligible for toll blocking at no charge.

SST may disconnect telephone service for the following reasons after providing at least ten (10) days from the date of notice to the customer of the company's intent to discontinue service. Notice is considered given to the customer

three (3) days after mailing. Electronic notice (via email or text) can also be considered given by delivering to the customer's listed email address or by text message to the customer's phone number.
