

Opinion: SQ 836, a bad idea with a track record

SQ 836 has not delivered on its promises anywhere it has been tried. This week, as paid signature gatherers make their final push, decline to sign.

The petition currently being circulated in Oklahoma claims to create an "open primary." In fact, it is not a primary at all. It is a California-style two-round voting system that does not allow parties to hold primaries.

This Top-2 system would block most independent

and third-party candidates from the November ballot, prompting Libertarian party candidate Chris Powel to write SQ 836 "would be a death knell for independent and alternative-party candidates in Oklahoma."

Louisiana had a system like this. After it pitted the Grand Dragon of the Ku Klux Klan against a convicted felon in the final vote for governor, they began moving away from it. Only California and Washington state have this system. In 2000 the U.S. Supreme Court threw out California's jungle primary. But, California tweaked it and

put it back in place in 2010.

Proponents argue SQ 836 will increase voter turnout, but the data simply do not support that claim. In fact, California's voter turnout is no better than Oklahoma's. In the 3 non-presidential elections since 2010 California had turnout of 25%, 41%, and 36%. Oklahoma had turnout of 28%, 40%, and 37%. Virtually identical. In 2006 and 2010 California's turnout was 33% and 37%. Oklahoma's was 34% and 37%. California's Top-2 system has not increased turnout.

Proponents also claim SQ 836 will reduce extreme candidates. Again, the available data do not support that argument. Research by Dr. Thad Kousser shows that if there is an effect, it is toward more extreme candidates. Another study shows California to be the most politically polarized state in the country. Washington is third.

What SQ 836 would actually do is make informed voting harder, increase the likelihood of incumbents winning, weaken governing teamwork, and limit your right to free association.

These outcomes are not speculative claims, they are backed up by peer reviewed research.

All of this prompted Dr. Seth Masket to title the last chapter of his book on election reforms "Quit Fixing It, You're Only Making It Worse."

If asked to support SQ 836, decline to sign.

gestures toward city employees while they were operating equipment because the equipment was in their way," Goldmann said. "That's not how people in Weatherford usually act. I would ask people to give consideration to city employees in situations like this."

Mayor Mike Brown added, "We certainly apologize that we weren't able to get everything done as quickly as we wanted to."

Brown also explained that nearly five years ago, responsibility for clearing main roads shifted from the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to the City of Weatherford. Prior to that change, ODOT handled roads including Main Street and the east and west access roads. Brown said this was the first major snowstorm Weatherford has experienced since assuming that responsibility and that the city would use it as a learning experience.

The mayor said officials

are considering alternative approaches to handling severe winter weather in the future. Options discussed included an agreement to use the county's snowplows or purchasing snow-plow attachments for city garbage trucks. Brown emphasized that the city is open to community suggestions.

"We are listening to what people are saying," Brown said. "Our guys did the best they could and worked as hard as they could to do the best job possible."

City Airport Manager Mark Schoonmaker also commended District 2 Custer County Commissioner Bruce Walker for personally clearing the runway at Stafford Airport.

"What he did in a couple of hours took us three days to do," Schoonmaker said.

Despite frustrations voiced by residents earlier in the week, no individuals publicly addressed the commission regarding road conditions during Thursday evening's meeting.
