Crupper moved to approve the minutes of the December 15, 2025 meeting as read. Seconded by Wesson. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

Unfinished Business: none.

Old Business: Crupper moved to appoint Paul Crupper as Chairman. Seconded by Fridde. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried. Fridde moved to appoint Brandon Wesson as Vice-Chairman. Seconded by Crupper. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, no, motion carried.

Crupper moved to appoint Troy Fridde and Brandon Wesson as Representatives to the Grand Gateway Board of Directors for 2026. Seconded by Wesson. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

On improvements to the courthouse Crupper stated that he was trying to get shold of Warren Cat about the generator since it was more than the switch. Fridde questioned Crupper about the hot water heater. Crupper stated he was having his secretary work on it. Wesson questioned if they had started working on the pipes in the Treasurer's office and the jail. Treasurer Rachel Marrs stated he had not heard anything about it. Crupper stated he would see about getting abold of Powell Mechanical today about that. Crupper stated he also needed to talk to them about getting a battery backup for the Commissioner's office in case something happened with the electric. Fridde requested that Demission check on Amazon for the price of one and the three districts will split the cost.

Wesson moved to approve a resolution that whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Nowata County, Oklahoma hereby adopts the fuel reimbursement rate of 7.5 cents per mile in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service for the actual year of 2026, now therefore be it resolved that this County Board of Commissioners of Nowata Oklahoma find that it would be in the best interest of the County to reimburse at a rate of 7.5 cents per mile for the actual year of 2026. Seconded by Fridde. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

Wesson moved to approve a leave share from Christy Imman an employee of the Court Clerk donating 500 hours of unused sick leave to Bob Cox, effective December 19, 2025. Seconded by Fridde. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

Fridde moved to approve the following resolutions: Whereas the Board of County Commissioners accept a donation from Cherokee Nation District 11 Tribal Counselor, Kendra McGee for a total amount of \$7,000.00, this donation amount is to be used for the sole purpose

of the Nowata County Sheriff's office, now therefore be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners find that it would be in the best interest of the County to accept this donation for the Nowata County Sheriff's office. Whereas the Board of County Commissioners accept a donation from Tim Carter and Janna Ketchum-Carter for \$200.00, this donation is to be used for the sole purpose of the Nowata County Sheriff's office, now therefore be it resolved that the Board of County Commissioners find that it would be in the best interest of the County to accept this donation for the Nowata County Sheriff's office. Seconded by Crupper, Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

On the quote from Cintras for the Zoll IPS AED automatic resuscitator County Clerk presented the Board with a quote for three upgraded AEDs which is one for the Court floor, one for the main floor and one for the Sheriff's office with the quote being \$1,000.00 per month. Fridde stated he thought it would be better to just buy them instead of renting. Fridde requested that County Clerk Secretary Alexandria Demission check on the total cost to purchase be made for.

Fridde moved to approve the Election Board reimbursement claims for November and December 2025 for \$3,375.00 each. Seconded by Crupper, Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried. On the road use agreement Crupper stated he had tried to contact three other counties but he has not heard anything back yet due to the holidays and he was hoping he would this week. Crupper moved to table. Seconded by Fridde. Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried. Fridde moved to approve the following appointments: Traci Bedell as First Deputy Court Clerk, as made by Court Clerk April Fruenberger, effective December 20, 2025, the appointment of Audrey L. Kallenberger as a full-time Deputy Court Clerk, as made by Court Clerk April Fruenberger, effective January 2, 2026. Seconded by Crupper, Crupper, yes, Fridde, yes, Wesson, yes, motion carried.

Fridde moved to approve a resolution that whereas the Board of County Commissioners of Nowata County made ad passes the following motion: be it further resolved, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nowata County find that they approve the election of directors of the Nowata County Free Fair Board and shall be held on Saturday February 7, 2026 from 12 pm to 4:00 pm at the Nowata County Courthouse Building 228 N. Maple Nowata OK 74848, filing period for said election shall commence on Tuesday, January 20, 2026 and shall end at the close of business on Monday January 26, 2026, no entries will be accepted before or after the close of business each day. 1. Wesson stated he was confused as to why, since the radios are Nowata County's, he is hearing complaints from ones that do not use our radios. Fridde stated we did this whole thing as a service to the first responders when we get the ARPA money, we decided that the communication to the first responders was a priority. Wesson questioned when does the complaining stop. Fridde stated that when the money runs out and it has run out. Sheriff Jason McClain stated the tower from the Courthouse to the newer tower. Fridde stated that elevation needed to be checked because he believes the new tower is not high enough.

On new business County Clerk Kay Spurgeon informed the Board that she had received an invoice for the Chamber of Commerce dues for \$150.00 and a purchase order would be made for.

There was no appropriation of funds. There was no allocation of alcoholic beverage.

There were no right of way permits and/or releases.
