This case arises from a data breach that occurred in March 2016 (the "March 2016 Data Breach") when an employee of Defendant released the W2s of hundreds of employees to cyber criminals. A W2 is an IRS form that contains "personal identifying information" or "PII", including each employee's name. address, social security number, annual compensation, and tax withholding information. Release of this type of PII can expose an individual to identity theft and other forms of fraudulent activity. Plaintiffs allege that the Defendant had a duty to protect the Class members' PII; that the Defendant breached its duty to protect the Class members' PII; that the Defendant provided insufficient assistance to Class members after the breach; and that the Class members are entitled to damages. The Defendant denies the lawsuit's allegations. The Court has not decided whether the Defendant is liable or whether the allegations of the lawsuit are true.
