All bids received at said time shall be publicly opened and read aloud. All work shall be performed and all construction and material used and furnished shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications prepared by Mears Engineers, LLC, and on file in the office of the South Coffeyville Public Works Authority. Each bidder shall accompany his original bid, with a certified or Cashier's Check on a solvent bank located in Oklahoma or a Bidder's Bond, in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount bid, as a guarantee of his ability to perform the contract bid upon, and that he will enter into a written contract with the Owner to perform said work and/or furnish said materials in accordance with said plans and specifications and furnish the required bonds within ten (10) days after the acceptance of his bid.

The deposit will be retained by the Owner as, and for, liquidated damages in case the successful bidder fails to enter in said contract and furnish the required bonds provided for in the specifications within the time required. Deposit of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon the execution of the Contract and required bonds.

Each bidder shall accompany his bid with a DW- 412 Noncollusion Affidavit and a DW-413 Business Relationships Affidavit in writing displaying that the Bidder has not directly or indirectly entered into an agreement, express of implied, with any other bidder or the price or amount of such bid or any bids, the limiting of the bids or bidders, the paying to anyone any money for promotion expenses, the parceling or farming out to any bidder or bidders or other persons of any part of the contract or any part of the subject matter of the bid or of the profits therefrom.

Performance, Maintenance and Statutory Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price with a Corporate Surety licensed in Oklahoma and approved by the Owner and Engineer, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract. A Maintenance Bond guaranteeing the repair of all damage due to improper materials or workmanship for a period of one (1) year, after the acceptance of the work by the Owner, will be required. This project is to be financed by a loan from the Oklahoma Water Resources Board through the Department of Environmental Quality Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) and shall be referred to as DWSRF Project No. P40-3005305-01.

A. "Equal Opportunity in Employment: All qualified applicants will receive considerations for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age or physical handicap. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications."

B. "Each bidder must fully comply with the requirement, terms and conditions of the Department of Environmental Quality Small, Minority, Women's Business Requirements including affirmative steps to contract with small, minority and women's businesses during the performance of this contract. The bidder commits itself to the affirmative steps to contract with small, minority and women's businesses contained herein and all other requirements, terms and conditions of these bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid. Requirements are contained in DEQ Guidance and Procedures, DW-700."

C. "All bidders must comply with the Anti-Kickback Act and the Contract Work Hours Standards Act. D. "Davis Bacon Act wage rules shall apply. All laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of a character similar in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of Chapter 31 of Title 40, United States Code. The Department of Labor provides all pertinent information related to compliance with labor standards, including prevailing wage rates and instructions for reporting. E. "American Iron and Steel provisions also apply to projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government pursuant to the

Safe Drinking Water Act, Section 1452(a)(4), requiring that all iron and steel products used for a project for the construction, alteration, maintenance or repair of a public water system are produced in the United States." F. "This project is subject to Build America, Buy America (BABA) Act requirements. The BABA Act requires none of the funds made available for a Federal financial assistance program for infrastructure, including each deficient program, may be obligated for a project unless all of the iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in the project are produced in the United States. The BABA Act requirement does not supersede the AIS requirement, and both provisions still apply and work in conjunction."

G. System for Award Management (SAM) registration is required for all DWSRF program applicants and Awardees (Entities, prime contractors, subcontractors, vendors) in order to be awarded contracts by the DWSRF program. SAM replaces Central Contractor Registration/Federal Agency Registration, Online Representations and Certifications Application, and Excluded Parties List System. Applicants and awardees are required to complete a one-time free registration to provide basic information relevant to procurement and financial transactions. New Applicants and awardees please go to Sam.gov to complete the registration process. Note: In order to register in SAM, a Unique Entity Identification (UEI) number will be required. A UEI is a 12-character (alpha-numeric) code that uniquely identifies all entities. Any entity registering to do business with the government in terms of contracts or grants and assistance awards is required to have one. Unique Entity IDs are issued by SAM.gov and are a part of an entity's record in the Entity Information section of SAM.gov.

The bids filed with the South Coffeyville Public Works Authority will be opened and considered by the South Coffeyville Public Works Authority, at a meeting to be held in the South Coffeyville Town Hall, 419 S. Willow St. South Coffeyville, Oklahoma at 1:00pm on the 29th day of April, 2026, but all bids shall remain on file at least forty-eight (48) hours thereafter before a contract will be made and entered into thereon. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours prior to the Bid Opening will be returned. A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on this project at 1:00pm on the 21st day of April, 2026, in the South Coffeyville Town Hall, 419 S. Willow St. South Coffeyville, Oklahoma. The contract is to be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bidding and the right to reject any and all bids in accordance with the Oklahoma Competitive Bidding Act. Marrs stated that this decision did not come lightly and we do this job out of love and not the paycheck. Marrs stated that she wanted to thank all the ones that have been supportive and for the others she hopes they never feel defeated. Friddle stated he want-

ed to thank her for all she has done. Wesson moved to accept Treasurer Rachael Marrs letter of resignation. Seconded by Friddle. Crupper yes, Wesson yes, Friddle yes, motion carried. Friddle moved to accept a letter of a two week notice from County Commissioners Secretary Alexandria Dennison, with her last day to be March 27, 2026. Seconded by Wesson. WHEREAS, by majority vote of the City of Nowata Board of Commissioners at a Special Meeting on the 23rd day of February, 2026, it was determined, upon the recommendation of City Administration that an increase in the rates charged for water and wastewater services is necessary to provide for a balanced budget for the current and upcoming fiscal year, to account for inflation and for additional expenses related to equipment, the new water tower, and operations, including the increased liability related to the State Legislature's increase of the allowable claim limits under the Governmental Tort Claims Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Nowata, Oklahoma, meeting in regular session on this 23rd day of February, 2026, as follows: Section One (1): That Section 17-302, titled "Wastewater Treatment Rate" of the Code of Ordinances, City of Nowata, Oklahoma, is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit: SECTION 17-302. WASTEWATER TREATMENT RATE

All users of the wastewater treatment system shall be charged Twenty Dollars and Thirty-four Cents (\$20.34) per month for the first one thousand (1000) gallons of metered consumption, plus a charge of Six Dollars and Twenty-six Cents (\$6.26) for each additional one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water usage.

Section Two (2): Section 17-213, titled "Water Rates", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Nowata, Oklahoma, shall be amended to read as follows: SECTION 17-213. WATER RATES

There shall be a minimum base charge for water services of Eighteen Dollars and Fifty-three Cents (\$18.53) per user per month for the first one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water used; plus an additional Five Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$5.70) per thousand gallon for the next two thousand (2,000) gallons of metered water used; an additional Six Dollars and Twenty-six Cents (\$6.26) per thousand gallons for the next one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water used; and an additional Six Dollars and Eighty-Eight Cents (\$6.88) per thousand gallons of metered water thereafter.

All Rural Water Districts shall be charged Seven Dollars and Thirty-Five Cents (\$7.35) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water consumption.

Section Three (3) Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, illegal or in conflict, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, or by any federal agency, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provisions to other persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby, and to this end, such portion of the Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent, provision and not affecting the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section Four (4): Repealer. Any Ordinance or Code provision, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are to that extent hereby repealed.

Section Five (5): Emergency Clause, Effective Date. There being an immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication one time, but its effective date shall commence at the beginning of the next billing cycle for the Nowata

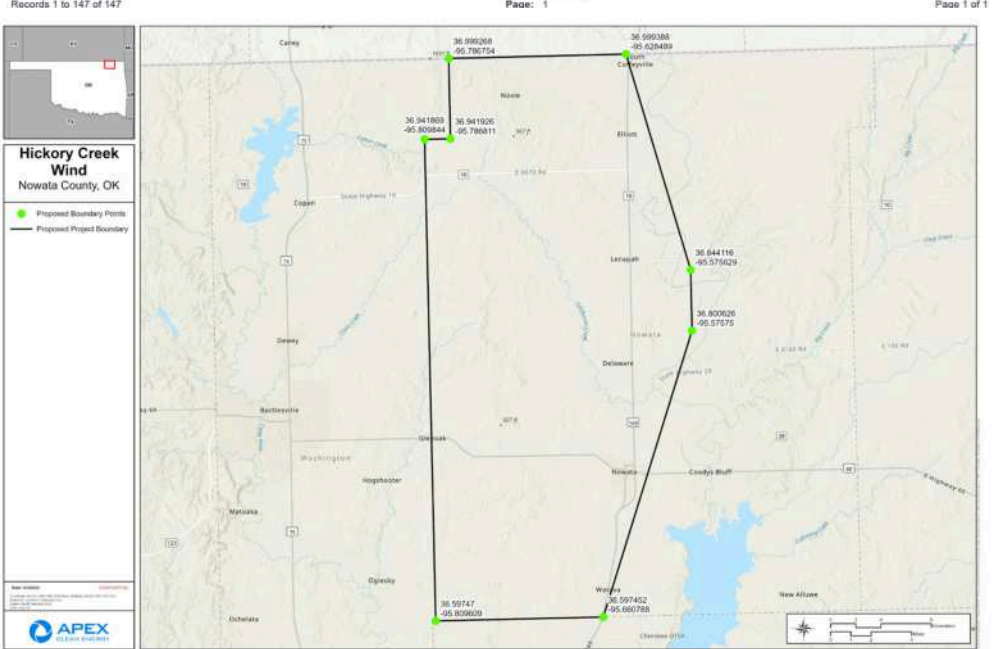
