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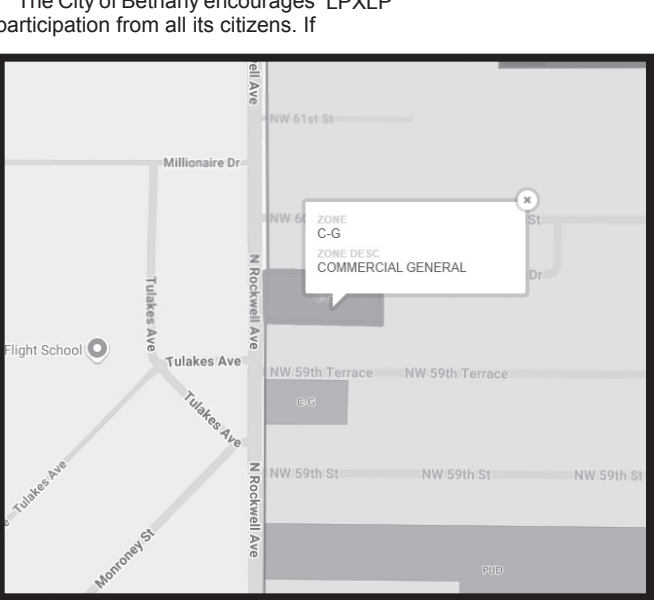

# LETTERS FROM DALE

Harold Wood was 12 years old when he joined the Boy Scouts of America in 1919. We have this heartwarming story of “Harold’s best Christmas” because in about 1934 his mother took time to write it down with a led pencil in a 5-cent lined notebook.

Maggie is my wife’s great-grandmother. Harold is her grand-uncle. We have this story because we recently found it in a forgotten box of Maggie’s things.

You may read the epilogue first if you wish. “Harold’s two older brothers were Scouts before him, and he was very much interested in the movement before he was old enough to join. There never was a more earnest sincere and devoted Scout than he.

“The Scout pledge was real to him. He took every phrase of it to heart. He fulfilled all requirements for advancement and was a First Class Scout before he was thirteen years old. Immediately, his scout master gave him the responsibilities of Patrol Leader and Bugler.

“The other boys of the troop were somewhat jealous of Harold because he had the Scout Trumpet. They all wanted to blow it and play with it. Harold was not pleased with the idea, because, aside from the damage done to the trumpet by the careless handling, was the danger of transmitting bad colds and other diseases from one to the other. The trumpet was too frail an affair to be squabbled over.

“His father got him a silver mouthpiece for the trumpet, as it was easier to keep it clean. Then, through the carelessness of some of the boys, the silver mouthpiece was lost. The troop was then required to get another one. This furnished an opportunity to teach care of property, be it public or private.

“The scouts had been meeting at the homes of different members, and one evening Harold came home all choked up with sobs he would not let through, telling his father and I how some of the boys were going to get scout suits.
