ORDINANCE NO. 2026-03-16 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WELCH, OKLAHOMA, AMENDING PART 2, SECTION 2-105, ENTITLED "TOWN CLERK-TREASURER, DUTIES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF WELCH, OKLAHOMA, RELATING TO THE OFFICIAL DUTIES OF THE TOWN CLERK-TREASURER, AND ALSO THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND OTHER DUTIES OF THE NON-ELECTED OFFICE COORDINATOR POSITION, AND SETTING A BEGINNING ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE NON-ELECTED OFFICE COORDINATOR POSITION OF \$36,000.00; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF WELCH, OKLAHOMA, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO PART 2, SECTION 2-105. That Section 2105, within Part 2, entitled "Town clerk-treasurer, duties", of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Welch, Oklahoma, shall be amended to recite in its entirety as follows: **Part 2 Section 2-105 Town Clerk-Treasurer duties.** The Town Clerk-Treasurer is an officer of the town. B. In addition to those duties specifically described in 11 O.S. § 12-109 and 11 O.S. §12-110, the person who serves as Town Clerk-Treasurer may have such other powers, duties and functions related to his or her statutory duties as may be prescribed by law or ordinance. c. When the words "treasurer" or "town treasurer" are used in this code or in other ordinances of the Town, they shall be deemed to mean the combined office of the Town-Clerk Treasurer or a Deputy Town Clerk-Treasurer unless another meaning is clearly indicated by the context. D. The person serving as Town Clerk-Treasurer may be employed by the Town of Welch and/or the Welch Public Works Authority (hereinafter "WPWA") to perform additional administrative or other duties, not specified by state law, as an employee of the Town of Welch and/or the WPWA. This position shall be hereinafter referred to as the "Office Coordinator". The additional administrative or other duties may be performed by the person serving as Town Clerk-Treasurer or as otherwise provided by motion or other action of the Town Board of Trustees and/or Trustees of the WPWA. The person performing additional administrative or other duties not related to the office of Town Clerk-Treasurer shall perform such duties at the pleasure of the Town Board of Trustees and/or

the Trustees of the WPWA and shall perform such duties as may be prescribed by the Town Board of Trustees and/or Trustees of the WPWA. The annual salary for the additional administrative or other duties of the "Office Coordinator" is \$36,000.00, payable in approximately equal payments according to the regular payroll schedule of the Town of Welch and/or the WPWA and shall also include any other benefits and/or increases in accordance with any personnel policy or other policy of the Town of Welch and/or the WPWA. Payment of the salary for additional administrative or other duties shall be contingent upon the full performance of the additional duties.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed to be a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, except that the effective date provision of this ordinance shall not be severable from the operative provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. It being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Welch, Oklahoma, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof the ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by state law. **PASSED AND APPROVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Welch, Oklahoma, this 16th day of March 2026, with the emergency clause being acted upon separately.

ORDINANCE 2026-3-26 AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WELCH, OKLAHOMA, AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL ELECTED OFFICIALS AND APPROVED DESIGNATED TOWN OF WELCH EMPLOYEES TO CARRY CONCEALED FIREARMS FOR THE SELF-DEFENSE PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL CARRY ACT; ADDING SECTION 2-112 OF PART 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND GOVERNMENT), CHAPTER 1 (GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature recently enacted House Bill 1095, known as the Municipal Carry Act, which amends 21 O.S. § 1277 to authorize municipalities to permit qualified municipal officials, judges, and approved designated municipal employees to carry concealed firearms in municipal buildings under certain conditions; and WHEREAS, the Town of Welch desires to provide for the safety and security of its officials, employees, and the public,

consistent with State law. **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF WELCH, OKLAHOMA:** Part 2 (Administration and Government), Chapter 1 (Government Organization), Section 2112 is hereby added to the Town of Welch Code of Ordinances to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 1 - Amendment. AUTHORIZATION TO CARRY CONCEALED FIREARMS. Pursuant to Municipal Carry Act and subject to limitations set forth herein, municipal elected officials and approved designated Town of Welch employees who have obtained a valid Oklahoma Concealed Carry License under the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act (21 O.S. S 1290.1 et seq.) are hereby authorized to carry concealed firearms on Town property and during the performance of their official duties for the purpose of lawful self-defense. **Section 2 - Amendment. AMENDMENT TO 21 O.S. 2021, SECTION 1277.** This ordinance shall operate as a local amendment consistent with the authority granted under 21 O.S. S 1277, which permits municipalities to authorize the carrying of concealed firearms by elected officials and designated employees on municipal property. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to conflict with state law or to authorize the carrying of firearms in a location prohibited by federal or state statute. **Section 3 — Limitations and Conditions.** (a) This authorization applies only to individuals who: 1. Are currently serving as elected officials of the Town, or are employed by the Town of Welch and approved by the Welch Board of Trustees to carry; 2. Hold a valid and current Oklahoma / Oklahoma approved Concealed Carry License; and 3. Are not prohibited from possessing firearms under state or federal law. (b) Concealed firearms may not be carried in any building or facility where carrying is prohibited by state or federal law. (c) The Board of Trustees may establish administrative policies for notification procedures between the Town and employees or elected officials for the purposes of including but not limited to locations where carrying a firearm is unlawful pursuant to state law, recordkeeping, and training related to this ordinance. **Section 4 — Severability.** If any provision, paragraph, word, section or article of this Ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions, paragraphs, words, sections and chapters shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. **Section 5 — Conflicting Provisions.** If any provision, paragraph, word, section or article of this Ordinance conflicts with the provisions of any other Ordinance, then the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have superseded all conflicting provisions previously entered into effect. **Section 6 — Effective Date.** Pursuant to 11 O.S. § 14— 103, this Ordinance shall take effect thirty days (30) days from its final passage. **PASSED AND APPROVED** on this date: 03/26/2026
