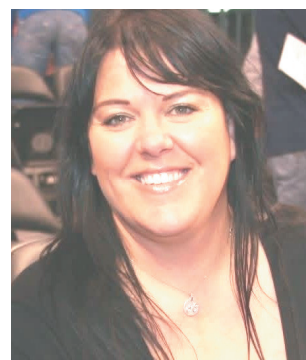

as a forward on the basketball team. After high school, Kristi attended Southwestern Oklahoma State University, majoring in English and minoring in journalism. She welcomed her son, Benjamin in 1992 and soon completed her education--earning a bachelor's degree in 1994.

One of her first jobs after college was working for the Weatherford Daily

News where she worked as an editor for the lifestyles section for over seven years. She also worked as the Information Education Coordinator for Deer Creek Conservation District, a Patient Success Coordinator for TheraWest, as an associate at Skin Zen, and as an animal lover, she greatly enjoyed her time as a vet assistant for Dr. Cox at All Creatures Animal Hospital.

Kristi was a lifelong SWOSU athletics fan, she also enjoyed gardening, being in nature, traveling, especially to Silver Dollar City, cooking, and spending time with her family during the holidays, her favorite being the Fourth of July.

Kristi was preceded in death by her parents, Benny Joe and Jolando Hill. She is survived by her son, Ben Hill and wife, Morgan, and their

from Weatherford High School in 1967.

Nova's life was immersed in bluegrass, country and gospel music. She was a founding member of a travelling family band, Country Couples, and later a local group, Yesterday's Tradition. Decades of Friday nights were spent performing at her uncle's venue, Denzle's Music Barn.

Nova held book keeping positions at

Centra Leather Goods, Cal-Gas, and at her then husband Gary Long's business, Comfort-Temp Heat & Air. Gary's fish keeping hobby ultimately lead her to establish The Aquarium Pet Store of Weatherford in 1985, which closed in 1999.

After a few years of owning/operating a small resort hotel in Arkansas, she returned to Weatherford to assist in her daughter's

new business, re-establishing the pet store in 2003. She retained an active sales role for many years, and then continued her book keeping role until her final days.

Nova had a love for animals, especially cats. She had many cherished kitties throughout her life and amassed quite a collection of miniature cat figurines.

Nova will be remembered most as

a loving and devoted mother by her daughter Amber Hudson, and husband, Chris, of Weatherford, OK.

A graveside service for interment of ashes will be at Greenwood Cemetery at 11 a.m., Saturday, June 27, followed by a "Come & Go" Celebration of Life in the lobby of Hudson Technology Solutions/The Aquarium Pet Store at 10319 N. 2410 Rd. Weatherford.

At the hearing the Court will decide whether to approve the Petition and waiver of the final inventory and accounting and petition for determination of heirs, and distribution if the Petitioner.
