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

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

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 5, ATRICLE 14,
SECTIONS 5-127 AND 5-129 OF
THE CITY OF WEATHERFORD
HOTEL TAX ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Board
of Commissioners of the City of
Weatherford, Oklahoma:

Section 1. Section 5-127 of
the City of Weatherford Hotel Tax
Ordinance addresses

DEFINITIONS necessary to
clarify terms used in the ordinance.
Section 5-129 addresses
EXEMPTIONS from the Hotel
Tax

Section 2. That section 5-127
of article 14 currently states as
follows:

Chapter 5, Article 14, section
5-127
DEFINITIONS.

As used in this article:
CITY – Shall mean the City of
Weatherford, Oklahoma.

CITY CLERK – Shall mean
the City Clerk of the City of
Weatherford, Oklahoma

HOTEL – Shall mean any
buildings, structures, trailers, or
any other facilities of any kind
or nature, in which the public
may, for consideration, obtain
sleeping accommodations in
which two or more rooms are
used for the accommodation
of such guests (regardless of
whether such rooms are located
in one or several buildings,
structures, trailers or facilities).
The terms shall include hotels,
motels, tourists homes, houses
or courts of any kind or nature,
lodging houses, inns, rooming
houses, bed and breakfast inns,
corporate lodgings, trailer houses,
trailer motels, apartments and
sleeping rooms and all other
similar facilities where rooms
or sleeping accommodations
are furnished for a consideration.
The terms shall not include
hospitals, sanitariums, nursing
homes or dormitories at
Southwester Oklahoma State
University or other educational
or charitable institutions.

OCCUPANCY – Shall mean
the use or possession, or the right
to use or possession of any room
or rooms in a hotel, or the right
to the use of possession of the
furnishings or to the services and
accommodations accompanying
the use and possessions of the
room or rooms.

OCCUPANT – Shall mean a
person, who for a consideration,

uses, possesses, or has the right
to the use or possession of any
room or rooms in hotel under any
lease, concession, permit, right to
access, license to use, or other
agreement.

OPERATOR – Shall mean
any and all persons operating a
hotel(s) in this city, including, but
not limited to the owner, proprietor,
lessee, sublessee, mortgagee
in possession, licenses, or any
other person otherwise operation
such hotel.

RENT - Shall mean the
consideration received for
occupancy valued in money.
Whether received in money or
otherwise. Including all receipts,
cash, credits, and property or
services of any kind or nature, and
also any amount for which credit
is allowed by the operator to the
occupant, without any deduction
therefrom whatsoever.

RETURN - Shall mean any
return filed or required to be filed
as herein provided.

ROOM - Shall mean any room
or rooms of any kind in any part
or portion of a hotel which is
available for or let out for use or
possessed for any purpose other
than a place of assembly. As
used herein, "place of assembly"
means a room or space which
is capable of being occupied by
25 or more persons and which is
used for educational, recreational
or amusement purposes and shall
include dance halls, cabarets,
night clubs, restaurants, any
room or space for public or private
banquets, feasts, socials, card
parties or weddings, lodge and
meeting halls or rooms, skating
rinks, gymnasiums, swimming
pools, billiards, bowling and table
tennis rooms, halls or rooms
used for public or private catering
purposes, funeral parlors, markets,
recreational rooms, concern halls,
broadcasting studios, and all
other places of similar type of
occupancy.

TAX - Shall mean the tax levied
pursuant to this article,

PERMANENT RESIDENT
- Shall mean an individual who
has resided in a room in a hotel
for not less than 30 consecutive
days, with permanent residency
to end when any break in such

residency occurs.

Section 5. That Section 5-129
of Article 14 currently states as
follows:

Chapter 5, Article 14, Section
5-129
EXEMPTIONS.

1. The following shall be exempt
from the tax levied in this article:

a. Any governmental agency,
employee thereof or individual that
is exempt from Oklahoma State
and Weatherford City sale taxes
shall also be exempt from the tax
levied in this article;

b. Any public school, college,
university or state-accredited
private school when paid directly
by the school, provided that its
primary purpose is not carrying
on a business for profit;

c. Any church, when paid
directly by the church, provided
that its primary purpose is not
carrying on a business for profit;
and

d. Any organization, corporation,
or association organized and
operated exclusively for religious,
charitable, philanthropic or
educational purposes provided
that its primary purpose is not
carrying on a trade or business
for profit.

2. Every operator shall document
the basis for which exemptions are
made pursuant to this section on a
form provided by the City Clerk,
or if no form is provided, in sufficient
detail as to be verified by the City
Clerk.

Section 6. That the following
code amendment shall be adopted,
to-wit:
Chapter 5, Article J 4, Section
5-129
EXEMPTIONS.

1. The following shall be exempt
from the tax levied in this article:

a. Any governmental agency,
employee thereof or individual that
is exempt from Oklahoma State
and Weatherford City sale taxes
shall also be exempt from the tax
levied in this article;

b. Any public school, college,
university or state-accredited

private school when paid directly
by the school, provided that its
primary purpose is not carrying
on a business for profit;

c. Any church, when paid
directly by the church, provided
that its primary purpose is not
carrying on a business for profit;

d. Any organization, corporation,

operated exclusively for religious,

that its primary purpose is not
carrying on a trade or business
for profit.

e. Any permanent resident,
as defined in Chapter 5, Article
14, Section 5-127 provided, any
individual who qualifies as a
permanent resident shall be entitled
to the exemption retroactive to the
first day of residency.

2. Every operator shall document
the basis for which exemptions are
made pursuant to this section on a
form provided by the City Clerk,
or if no form is provided, in sufficient
detail as to be verified by the City
Clerk.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall
take effect on July 1, 2026, and be
in full force after its effective date,
approval and publication.

Finally in June we stopped traveling and started working in our office in Oxnard, CA.

The hardest thing was that we were far away from family. My family was in Germany, and my husband's family was in Phoenix. Our first son was born on September 27th, 1996, at the Ventura County hospital. My labor pains had started the day before and the first time we went to the hospital we were sent back home, the second time I went to the hospital it was too late for any pain medication. I had the full birth experience.

Our first son was quite challenging – we found out later that he is on the autism spectrum and has ADHD. Because of that experience I was not considering having a second child. Lo and behold, the following March we found we were pregnant with our second child. I was devastated and heartbroken, I was convinced that I would not be able to handle a second child. At this point we were struggling financially since we were both serving in a faith ministry.

For a fleeting moment I considered abortion, but I am so glad the Lord steered me away from that. On December 11th, 1997, we had our second son and a beautiful birth story to go along with it.

My husband and I were at Ventura First Church of the Nazarene. I was performing a play called "Handmaiden of the Lord" (Mary just before she gives birth to Jesus). This was the one time I was performing this play while actually pregnant. I came to the end – Mary prays and then calls for

Joseph's help as labor starts and the curtain closes with the sentence "Come Joseph, the time is upon me and I need your strong hands by my side." The Pastor thought that the ending was very realistic. A few minutes later I told my husband, please pack everything up "The time is upon me". We put everything into our car, got our son out of the nursery and went home. My husband thought it would be a long time still so he started watching...football, baseball, basketball...who knows. I was miserable and tried everything to just breathe slowly. Finally I went to the bathroom and called out: "Jeff I don't have to go to the bathroom, the baby is coming."

He finally got into gear and jumped up and got ready to go, by the time he came out of the front door I almost had the baby on the front lawn. He got me into the car and begged me not to do anything until we got to the hospital. As a careful driver, he kept driving the speed limit. I just knew I would feel so much better if the head came out. Quietly, I pushed and as we finally parked in the hospital parking lot, I lifted my dress and said: "Look the head is out." He panics and tells me to put the dress down and runs to the entrance of the hospital. I opened the car door, put up my legs to get the rest of him out, meanwhile a girl about 16 walks up to the car and asks me if I need help. She helps me to pull out the rest of Benjamin, for a split second he doesn't breathe and I start to panic. Benjamin looks blue, she gives him a slap on the backside and he

starts breathing. Even though she wrote her name down for me, I never heard from her again and believed that she was an angel.

My husband returns and covers him up with the blankets we had as props during the play and finally drives to the emergency entrance, and we end up in the hospital and all I can say is "They are taking my baby". Benjamin was born right after church, the next Sunday he was in church and today he is a Youth pastor with triplets married to a beautiful woman named Sarah.

I am glad I was able to take my children to Germany while they were young. The first time we went Benjamin was 9 months old and Nathaniel was almost two. We went several times during their childhood and our sons got to experience German culture.

The hardest moments as a mother were the ones where I felt alone, because my mom was in Germany, so far away and I would have appreciated her advice in many situations.

The greatest moments in motherhood came because I made time for my children. Spending every evening reading with both of them before bedtime, praying for both of them every night. There never was one great moment, but there were so many great little moments. I was there when each one of my sons accepted Jesus in their heart. Both of my sons went to a large Nazarene Youth conference. I am so glad I spurred them on in their fundraising for this conference. This is where my youngest son experienced his call to ministry for the first time, which was later confirmed.

Even though I am from Germany, my kids grew up in the States, but I did try to keep some German culture alive. Every Advent we had an advent wreath in our house, each Sunday we lit a candle as we sat around the wreath, we sang Christmas carols and read an advent devotion together. In Germany it is a tradition that we have coffee and cake in the afternoon. Especially when our kids

were little, I practiced that. If we meet on Sundays we still have coffee and cake in the afternoon.

Mother's Day is celebrated with special cake and coffee in the afternoon which is a tradition in our house. Even though they may not keep these traditions I am still glad we practiced them.

The one thing I like to end with is that even though my kids are adults they know that they can come with any problem to me and that I will listen, give advice when needed, help if I can and definitely pray with them.

For example, when my youngest son came home from 6th grade and told me: "Mom, since you were in India and that is close to China, I volunteered you for the main dish when we are celebrating Chinese New Year." This mom didn't know about all the frozen food that exists in the USA and made potstickers from scratch and made her son happy.

I support my kids in all they do and pray that God will lead them along the right path.

Industry analysts say operators continue concentrating investments in Oklahoma's most productive formations while reducing activity in less competitive areas. According to Oklahoma Energy Today, the Granite Wash in western Oklahoma has also maintained steady drilling numbers, while plays such as the Mississippian and Ardmore Woodford have seen little to no recent activity.

Despite the recent increase, Oklahoma's drilling totals remain below previous years. According to Baker Hughes data cited by Oklahoma Energy Today, Oklahoma carried between 42 and 46 active rigs during parts of spring 2026 compared to roughly 53 to 55 rigs during the same period a year earlier.

The Anadarko Basin remains one of the nation's major oil and natural gas regions, stretching across western Oklahoma into parts of Texas, Kansas and Colorado.

According to industry data firm Novi Labs, the basin has benefited from

advances in horizontal drilling and hydraulic fracturing technologies that have improved long-term production efficiency.

Production in the basin also remains significant. According to OilPriceAPI estimates from early May, the Anadarko Basin was producing roughly 475,000 barrels of oil per day alongside approximately 7.5 billion cubic feet of natural gas daily.

At the same time, permitting activity suggests companies remain cautious compared to earlier shale expansion years. According to data compiled from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission and reported by OilPriceAPI, statewide drilling permits were down more than 33% year-over-year as of mid-April.

Industry analysts have noted that many energy companies now prioritize profitability and operational efficiency over the aggressive expansion strategies that defined previous shale booms, leading to more measured growth across Oklahoma's oil and gas sector.
