Rovenstine stated that Craig County, all nine Indian Tribes and two counties from Kansas have already signed a letter showing their support against the transmission lines. Barbara Bottoms stated that one of the proposed lines goes right thru the middle of her property and she would appreciate their support. Wesson stated he hasn't heard of a definite place where the lines are going. Bottoms stated that she was told there is no definite place but they are down to 3 proposed line routes. Wesson stated he was totally against this. Katie Shipley stated they have put in a lot of work in the 17 years they have owned her land and she does not want it ruined. Shipley stated her kids play in the pasture where

the line is proposed and it is really scary to possibly work under high voltage lines. Alice Odgen stated that this is for the safety for all of us. Friddle stated he was not against the power lines but the best thing about Nowata is the land owner has the say about what is on their land and he was against someone forcing you to do something on your land. Friddle stated he would do whatever he could to stop eminent domain. Friddle moved to table this so it could be sent to Assistant District Attorney Ashley Kane for her opinion and also for the County Clerk to put this on the Board's letterhead. Seconded by Crupper. Crupper yes, Wesson yes, Friddle yes, motion carried.
