The town of South Coffeyville reserves the right to bill for services provided by the South Coffeyville Fire Department for services provided by the fire department in response to a fire or incident outside the city limits of South Coffeyville that is supported by the Town of South Coffeyville Fire Department response district. The fee schedule at City Hall has the fee charged by unit/hour.

Crupper moved to approve the minutes of the January 26, 2026 meeting as read. Seconded by Friddle. Crupper yes, Wesson yes, Friddle yes, motion carried.
Unfinished Business: none.
Old Business: On improvements to the courthouse Crupper stated that he had gotten a quote on the

hot water tank and it was \$1946.86 from Grainger. Friddle questioned how much was it on Amazon. Crupper stated Amazon did not have any. Crupper stated he had gotten a quote from Perkins Heating and Air for the maintenance on the air condition units and one was for every two months at \$55,575.00 a year and the other was every 3 months at \$37,000.00 per year and they were including the boiler and chiller in the price. Crupper stated he can call them back to see about a revised quote. Friddle stated no they need to find out what Hayes charged when they cleaned it and changing the filters should be an inside job and if it can not be done by the person we are paying then we need to figure something out. Friddle stated that since we already pay an employee for the maintenance then he did not think that we should do this but he did think it was a good idea for cleaning the coils every six months. Friddle stated that the chairman could take care of this.

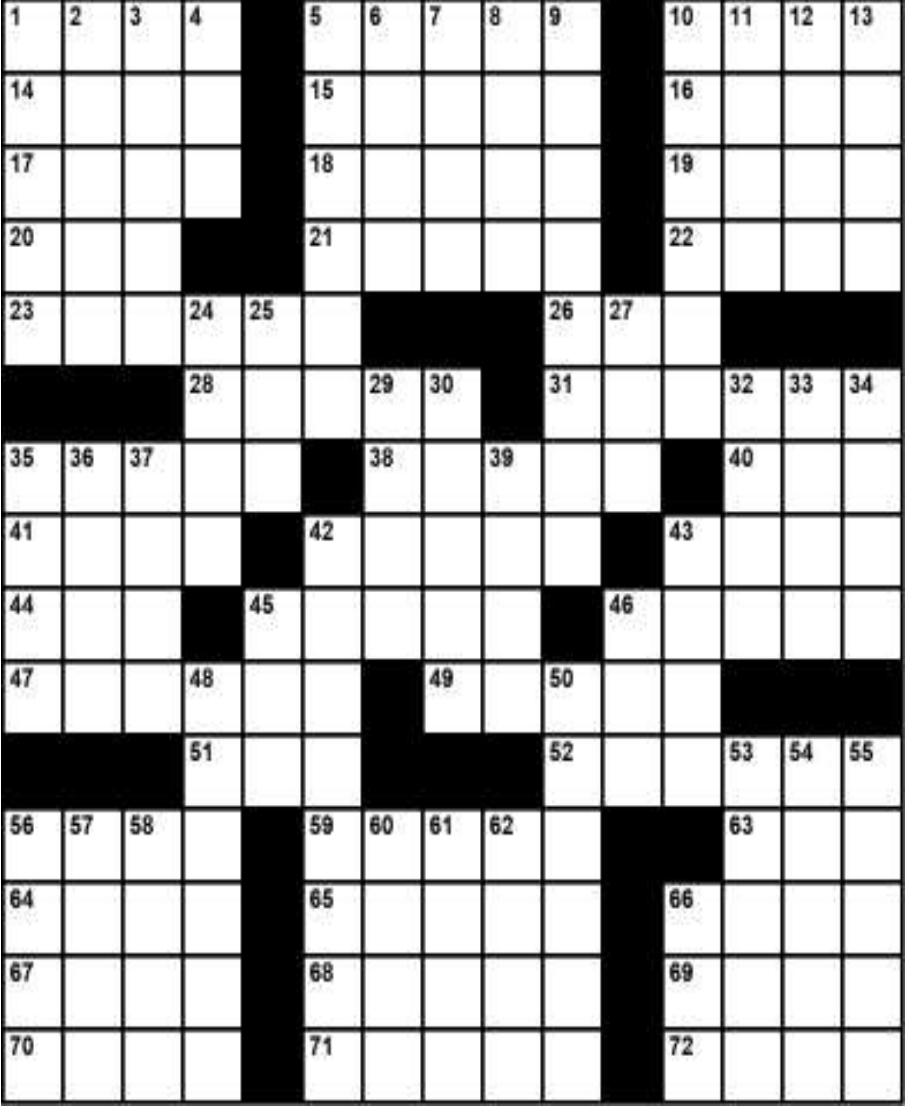

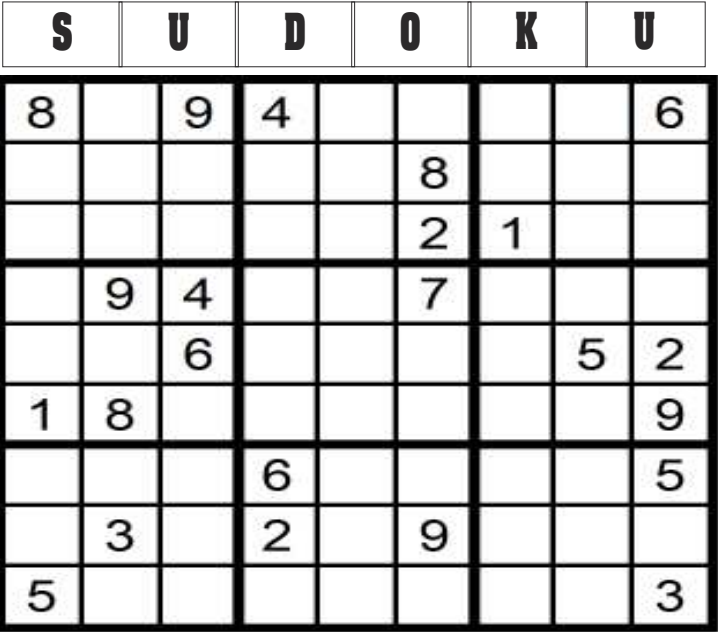
